Birthday Invitations

Note from the Nurse

If a student is going to be absent from school, please call or Email by 9:00am with the reason for the absence. If the absence is due to an illness, please leave two symptoms.

When to Stay Home

- * Fever greater than 100 degrees
 - You must be fever free for 24 hours without the use of Tylenol or Ibuprofen.
- * Vomiting and/or Diarrhea (watery stools)
 - You must not have vomited or had diarrhea in the last 24 hours.
- * Strep throat
 - You must be on antibiotics for 24 hours before returning to school.
- * Any disease that requires antibiotics
 - You must be on antibiotics for 24 hours before returning to school.
