## **Drop off and Pick Up Procedures**

Please remember that students are to be dropped off along the curb by the new addition in the mornings. Please keep the area by the main doors clear between 7:55 and 8:05 AM for bus drop offs.

During the afternoon, cars should stop once the buses start pulling out from their loading zone. We have asked the first bus in line, since it is a little longer than the other buses, to park a little more parallel to the curb so he needs a little more room at the south end of the building. So if the south parking lot seems a little tighter for spots this year, that is why.

### **Note from the Nurse**

If a student is going to be, absent from school, please call or Email by 9:00am with the reason for the absence. If the absence is due to an illness, please leave two symptoms.

### **When to Stay Home**

- \* Fever greater than 100 degrees
  - You must be fever free for 24 hours without the use of Tylenol or Ibuprofen.
- \* Vomiting and/or Diarrhea (watery stools)
  - You must not have vomited or had diarrhea in the last 24 hours.
- \* Strep throat
  - You must be on antibiotics for 24 hours before returning to school.
- \* Any disease that requires antibiotics
  - You must be on antibiotics for 24 hours before returning to school.
