Board Minutes – September 10, 2018

A special meeting of the North Scott Board of Directors was held on Monday, September 10, 2018, at 5:00 p.m. at the Administration Office. Members present were: John Maxwell, Molly Bergfeld, Joni Dittmer, Glen Keppy, Tracy Lindaman, Mark Pratt and Donn Wilmott.

President Maxwell called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.

Superintendent's Recommendation for Expulsion of a Student

The superintendent is recommending the expulsion of a student for violating Board policy. The superintendent is requesting a closed session to present the rationale for this recommendation.

Closed Session

Dittmer moved to hold a closed session to conduct a hearing to suspend, expel or exclude a student, unless an open session is requested by the student, or a parent or guardian of the student if the student is a minor, in compliance with Chapter 21.5(1) (e), Code of Iowa. Seconded by Keppy. ROLL CALL: Ayes – Maxwell, Bergfeld, Dittmer, Keppy, Lindaman, Pratt, Wilmott; nays - none. The board went into closed session at 5:01 p.m.; then returned to open session at 6:02:p.m.

Open Session - Board Action Regarding the Superintendent's Recommendation for Expulsion of a Student

Bergfeld moved to accept the superintendent's recommendation for expulsion. The Student is expelled from the North Scott Community School District indefinitely. In no circumstances will this period of expulsion be for less than one full calendar year. To the extent student wishes to re-enroll in the North Scott Community School District, he must first seek and receive permission from the North Scott Community School District Board of Education. If such permission is granted, the Board will create a plan for student's education. During such period of expulsion, the student is not allowed on any North Scott Community School District property or at any school event where a North Scott team is participating and the student is directed not to have any inappropriate contact with any witness involved in this situation.

The District will provide student's parents with information about continued school involvement, which may consist of information on home schooling and/or online classes.

Seconded by Lindaman. ROLL CALL: Ayes – Maxwell, Bergfeld, Dittmer, Keppy, Lindaman, Pratt, Wilmott; nays - none. Motion carried.

There being no further business, Pratt moved to adjourn; seconded by Wilmott. Meeting adjourned at 6:06 p.m.
