Officials: Two Certified IHSAA officials per court.

Game Rules:

All Grade Divisions: Iowa Federation 5-on-5 rules will be used. Three point shots will be allowed. Small (28.5) basketball will be used. No zone defense in the half court. Teams can full court press. All games will consist of two 18-minute halves. Each team will receive two 60-second timeouts per game. One and one shots will be taken on the 7th to 9th foul, ten and over will result in two foul shots. *No full-court press after a 20-point lead.*

	Game Kule Summary
Half:	18 minute continuous clock, except the last :30 of the 1st half and the last 2 minutes of the 2nd half (unless a team is ahead by 15 or more). During these last minutes, normal game clock stoppages will occur.

Halftime:	3 minutes. May be shortened as needed to help stay on schedule. Warm up periods prior to games may also be shortened to help stay on schedule.
Timeouts:	2 60-second timeouts per game. No carry-over into overtime. After a timeout, if a free throw is being shot, the clock will start when play becomes live.
Overtime:	Overtimes will be sudden-death, unless it is the championship game. Championship game will be 2 minutes with NO timeouts.
Special:	No full court press when leading by 20 or more points. Any contact with a side basket will be considered out of bounds.
	If any coach/player is assessed a technical foul, 2 points will be awarded to the opposing team plus possession of the ball to be inbounded across from the scorer's table.
	2nd 3rd and 4th Grade Divisions:
	Teams can ONLY FULL-COURT PRESS the last TWO MINUTES of each half.

Pool Play Tie-Breaker Rules: In the event of a tie after regulation pool play, placement in your pool will be decided by the following criteria. (Only if pool play is used).

1st – Winner of the game played between the two teams.	2^{nd} – Least total points scored against you while on defense.
3 rd – Most total points scored while on offense.	4^{th} – Flip of a coin.

Coaches: Know the rules of bench conduct. You must stay on the bench except for the circumstances permitted by the rules. Good sportsmanship is expected from you as well as your players and fans. Officials will not tolerate anything less. Should you be ejected from a game, you will be asked not to coach any subsequent games during our tournament. Only two coaches will get in for free.

Players: Team rosters will be established at the time of the first game and must be used throughout the tournament. A lower grade player may play in a higher grade division. Players cannot play on more than one team during this tournament. Players DON'T have to be from the same school district. A signed waiver by each player must be turned in at sign prior to a team's first game.

Facilities: The North Scott Junior High School and High School gyms and cafeteria are available for our use, but this is not a school tournament. The North Scott School District will not be responsible for injuries, accidents or losses that may occur. Locker rooms are not available. Coaches are responsible for supervising their teams. Team standings or brackets during the tournament will be visible on game bracket posters at the high school and junior high gyms.

Uniforms & Equipment: Teams should bring both light and dark colored uniforms. Uniforms must have numbers on the backs of shirts. The team listed at the top of the bracket (listed first) will be the home team and wear light colored uniforms. Teams need to bring their own practice basketballs.

Awards: Ten awards per team will be awarded to the 1st place and 2nd place teams in each Division.

Concessions: Food and beverages will be available in the school cafeteria. There are plenty of tables in the cafeteria to accommodate the teams and fans between games. Water bottles for players are allowed on the team benches.
