SETTING STUDENTS UP FOR SUCCESS

We challenge students with a diversified curriculum, encouraging them to develop as individuals. While we are proud of our students' high achievement on state assessments, we also know that children are more than a test score. We focus on providing the learning opportunities students need to set and reach ambitious goals long after graduation.

- 95% of 2021 graduates took a college class

We partner with Eastern Iowa Community Colleges to give students a head start while saving time and money. We currently offer certificate or career track options in agriculture, arts, automotive, construction, education, health occupations, nursing, and welding – with 7 more options in development.

Teams of educators meet weekly to ensure they meet their students' needs, discussing their strengths and opportunities for improvement.
