

FOREIGN EXCHANGE PROGRAM

1. No foreign exchange student shall be placed in a North Scott School without prior notification of the school authorities and their concurrence, in writing, in the placement.
2. There shall not be more than one student per agency in any one year. Exceptions may be made upon the approval of the administration.
3. The sponsoring organization shall be responsible for all fees, activity pass, yearbooks, class rings, supplies, etc. The sponsoring organization shall also be fully responsible for adjustment difficulties in the family and shall provide host families with a responsible person from within the Mississippi Bend AEA to contact in case of problems.
4. Programs not adhering to any and all guidelines established by the U.S. Department of State in addition to the above shall not be permitted to place foreign exchange students in North Scott Schools.
5. All programs desiring to enroll foreign exchange students in the North Scott Schools shall provide host families with a copy of these guidelines upon notification of their selection as a host family.
6. Recommendation for acceptance of foreign exchange individuals shall be a function of a designated high school official. If the student is unable to demonstrate sufficient oral communication skills to the satisfaction of the North Scott School District, it is the **sponsoring organization's** responsibility to place the student in an **alternate** school district.
