

CHILD CARE PROGRAM  
GOALS AND PURPOSES

The child care program is an early childhood program administered by the North Scott Community School District. As such, the child care program is guided by the goals and philosophies of the district as a whole. In addition, the main goal of the program is to offer the best possible preschool and/or daycare services given the resources available and the age, abilities, and needs of the child.

The staff will attempt to help each child realize a feeling of positive self-worth and self-assurance, enhance the child's learning and understanding of others, and aid the child in the development of pride in the child's achievements and progress. Preschool activities are not a duplication of the kindergarten program. The child care programs are carefully designed to stimulate motivation and learning in a controlled, non-threatening atmosphere.
