

CHILD CARE PROGRAM
WITHDRAWAL - DISCHARGE

Parents wishing to withdraw their child from the program must give notice at least one week in advance.

Within the discretion of the director, a child may be discharged from the center for the following reasons:

- Inadequate enrollment and information forms
- Incompatibility between the child and the program
- Violation of policies and rules
- Non-payment of fees
- Continued schedule infractions
- Continued disruptive and/or aggressive behavior
- Any other reason whereby the director deems that the child's enrollment in the program is not in the best interest of the program

In all instances, a conference will be arranged by the director with the parents prior to the possible discharge.
